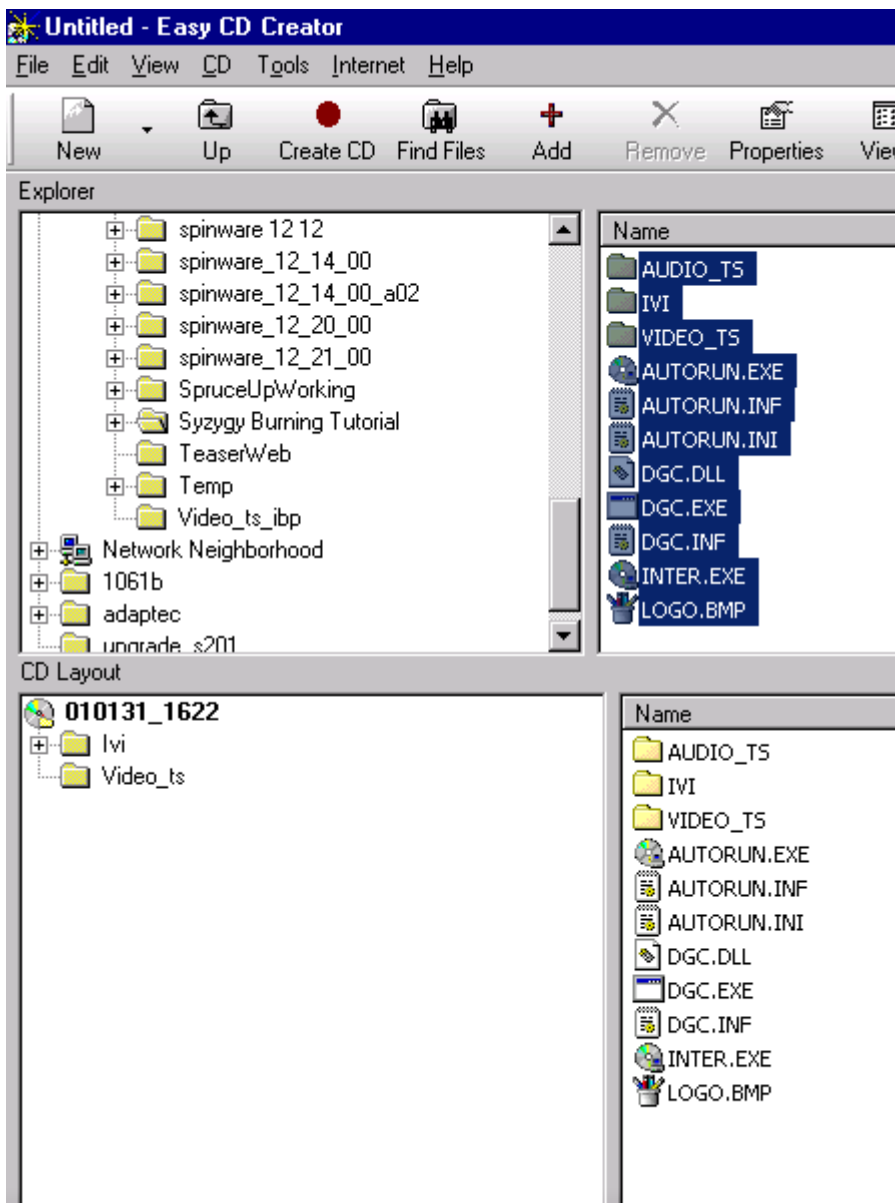


## How to incorporate DVD Global Communication

There are 4 main steps to incorporate **DVDFire** in to Syzygy-enabled DVD Title Set :

1. Create Syzygy-enabled DVD Title Set (VIDEO\_TS/AUDIO\_TS) with Web/Application links
2. You must save your VIDEO\_TS/AUDIO\_TS folder to the ROOT of a drive
  - i. If Drive C, then C:\ VIDEO\_TS/AUDIO\_TS
  - ii. If Drive D, then D:\ VIDEO\_TS/AUDIO\_TS
  - iii. From here on we will assume you are using Drive D
    - a. You must save the Syzygy files to the same Drive
      - i. For Drive D, we should see D:\Ivi\WinDVD\syzygy.exe, etc...
    - b. You must save the DVDFire files to the same Drive



3. Edit DGC.INF in accordance with your requirements

Your DGC.INF should look like this:

```
[main]
\ivi\WinDVD
[Application]
syzygy.exe
[Registration]
*****
[Redirections]
URL1:www.yoursite1.com
URL2:www.yoursite2.com
[Dominants]
```

4. Burn your disk (3 main parts)

- a. Title Set (VIDEO\_TS/AUDIO\_TS folders)
- b. Syzygy player (IVI/WinDVD/[syzygy files])
- c. [DVDFire files]

## Test your Title Set on the HDD

To Test your Title Set on the HDD – just launch autorun.exe

**Once you're sure everything behaves the way you'd like in Syzygy as played from the hard drive, it's time to burn...**

Remember that the Syzygy files are in \ivi\WinDVD in this picture

## How to Create Syzygy-enabled DVD Title Set

- a. Whether you're using Maestro, Virtuoso, Conductor or SpruceUp this is the same step. Use the Spruce Authoring program you have to create your DVD Video Title Set. Use the program to test for things like navigation and proper flow (simulate your movie).
- b. Once you have a Title Set you feel comfortable with, it's time to insert "web links" (in parens because you can actually link to any file with a valid path)
  - i. Web-links should begin with: http://
    1. all slashes in a Web-link are forward ("/")
  - ii. Local links should begin with: dvd:\
    1. all slashes in a Local link are backward ("\")
  - iii. Web-links and Local links may be attached to menu buttons or chapter points.
  - iv. You must insert at least one link (or simply rename a chapter

point) in order to avoid an error message from the player stating that no web links were found.

**IMPORTANT NOTE: On computer systems with DVD-ROM drives and installed DVD Player software, the DVD Player software may ignore the autorun when there is a Video\_ts on the disc. The disc should play correctly but the embedded weblink will be ignored. It is advisable to include instructions how to manually launch syzygy player.**

If the default DVD Player ignores the autorun and starts automatically, hold down the SHIFT key on the system as you insert the CD, and hold it down until you see the disk name next the the CDROM drive name in Windows Explorer. Then you can rightclick

on the CDROM drive in Windows Explorer and choose AUTOPLAY. Alternately, you can browse to [CDROM] and double click autorun.exe to begin.
